



## **SCHOOL BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES**

WHAT IS THIS RESOURCE FOR? This one-pager provides a list of key items school boards are responsible for including consequential decisions that shape every aspect of students' education and offer numerous opportunities to dismantle systemic racism.

- 1. School boards recruit, hire, support and **evaluate the district Superintendent**.
- 2. School boards **provide fiscal management**, including strategically allocating resources and approving the district budget.
- 3. School boards **develop goals and guardrails** for the district that reflect their values and priorities.
- 4. School boards write and pass policy and hold the system accountable for execution.
- 5. School boards **represent the community** and are responsible for effective and authentic 2-way communication and partnership.
- 6. School boards **authorize charter schools** and approve **school performance frameworks** to ensure their quality and access.
